
June Meeting

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order at 7:30pm on May 15th, 2015 by the President, David KB3UBD. Other board members present included the Vice President, Linda W5LMC; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer, Terry KD5RA; Emergency Coordinator, Bill AE5BT; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Editor, Dennis N5ACK; and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF.

David KB3UBD called the meeting to order and asked the attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

The minutes for the April meetings were submitted for publication in the May 2015 newsletter. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Terry KD5RA reviewed the treasurer's report from the month of April. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the financial report as published.

Phil N5PWW continues to hold test sessions on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 10am. There are no training classes currently being conducted. When a sufficient number of people express an interest, Phil will hold a class.

Dennis N5ACK published the May 2015 newsletter and brought additional copies to the meeting.

Bill AE5BT informed the membership that Field Day will be held on June 27th, and that setup of the stations and antennas will start at 9am. There will be a Get On The Air (GOTA) station, as well as side-band, VHF, and UHF. Anyone can visit and operate the equipment as there will be supervising control operators. Dinner is planned for 6pm and the membership is encouraged to bring a side-dish to complement the BBQ main course.

Maurice KM5RF reported that the new repeaters were installed on April 30th and they are operating well.

Linda W5LMC thanked the AARC members who assisted with communications for the Lone Star Half Marathon. She also conveyed the thanks of the race organizers (Arlington Fire Department, and promoters) to the members. Linda is looking for volunteers to provide communications for the Arlington Fourth of July Parade.

A break was taken at 8:08pm. At 8:20 pm the meeting resumed with a presentation by Maurice KM5RF on the use of the new repeater system.

The meeting adjourned at 8:52pm. The sign-in sheet showed 37 people in attendance, 33 indicating AARC membership.
