K5SLD Celebrates Radio Scouting

This fall The Arlington ARC worked with the Boy Scouts of America at two separate events to further the cause of amateur radio in scouting. Many scouts are not even aware of amateur radio or its connection with the scouts, so we did our best to expose these youngsters to one of the more technical, personal and far-reaching activities which is available to them as scouts. In October Bill Tatsch AE5BT, Dave Spore KB3UBD, Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Dave Walker W5DJO, and Virginia Smith NV5F took their portable gear out to Sid Richardson Scout Ranch to celebrate JOTA - Jamboree on the Air, a worldwide radio scouting event. The idea was to get scouts talking to other scouts on the radio. Then the second weekend in November, the same intrepid crew set up an amateur radio booth on the midway at the Longhorn Council Camporee, an event which hosts thousands of area scouts every four years at Texas Motor Speedway. The weather was perfect and we met hundreds of scouts. And thanks to Dave Walker and his 2 meter setup, and the Arlington repeater, many of the boys jumped on the air for a chat with local hams. Virginia demonstrated global HF communication as well as Morse code. And of course Bill's long time connection with scouting went a long way in planning and executing these outings. For us they were like a miniature Field Day, and we certainly learned a great deal on both occasions, perhaps even more than the scouts did! Thanks to all who participated!

Absent was the Emergency Coordinator, Bill AE5BT.

David KB3UBD called the meeting to order and asked the attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

A motion was made and carried to accept the September meeting minutes as published in the October newsletter.

Trey AF5XS published and distributed the October newsletter.

Maurice KM5RF reported that the repeaters are working well. For 2017, he would like to install an RF amplifier on the VHF repeater. As Treasurer, Maurice sent to the membership the financial reports for the months of July, August, and September. These reports were published in the October newsletter. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the reports as published.

David KB3UBD met with the Chair of the Membership Committee to discuss upcoming events and opportunities to bring new members into the club.

Ham of the Year ballots are currently being accepted from now until the November meeting. The winner will be announced at the holiday party in December.

A break was taken at 8:10 pm and resumed at 8:22 pm with a presentation by Maurice on the topic of Ufer grounding.
