From ARRL

FCC Reduces Proposed Amateur Radio Application Fee to \$35

The FCC has agreed with ARRL and other commenters that its proposed \$50 fee for certain amateur radio applications was "too high to account for the minimal staff involvement in these applications." In a *Report and Order* (*R&O*), released on December 29, the FCC scaled back to \$35 the fee for a new license application, a special temporary authority (STA) request, a rule waiver request, a license renewal application, and a vanity call sign application. All fees are per application. Administrative updates, such as a change of mailing or email address, are exempt.

# **Meeting Minutes**

# November 2020 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was held via teleconference and called to order on November 20th, 2020 at 7:32 pm by the President, David K5NN. David K5NN called the meeting to order.

Virginia NV5F informed the membership that the program for the evening would be presented by Dr. Ed Albin from American Public University on the topic of radio astronomy.

Andy KB2VQA noted that the November newsletter contained the minutes from the October meeting. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Maurice KM5RF was not present. David K5NN reviewed the financial report. A motion was made and carried to accept the report for audit as published.

Trey AF5XS compiled and distributed the newsletter for November.
