Field Day

Rob May and Bill Tatsch will be updating us about Field Day, with where we are and what we still need to get ready. From Rob:

We'll be all together at the club meeting room at 501 W. Sanford. For some of the new members, use the south entrance of the building that is just off of N. Cooper and Sanford. We will have a club meeting the week before so you'll have a chance to get your bearings before Field Day. As usual, we'll be class 3A. We will have a digital station doing FT8, a CW station, and of course a Sideband (also called Phone, in amateur radio all voice modes can be called "phone"). We'll have two bonus stations, a VHF/UHF station (I see this as mostly doing 6 meter phone and digital) and a Get on the Air (GOTA) station. The GOTA station is for non-amateurs, new amateurs, and inactive amateurs. So, if you're a new ham, or interested in becoming a ham, or if you haven't been on the radio in a year or more, make the GOTA station your first stop. We especially welcome our younger, future hams. We've had operators as young as 3 and 4, so bring the kids/grandkids/great-grandkids. We will be using the club's callsign K5SLD, except for the GOTA station which will use the callsign of the control operator

ISS

The Amateur Radio on the International Space Station (ARISS) cross-band repeater will be available for ARRL Field Day, June 26 - 27. Contacts will count toward Field Day bonus points as satellite contacts and Field Day contacts. Field Day rules limit stations to one contact on any single-channel FM satellite. Note that contacts made during Field Day by ISS crew would only count for contact credit, but not for satellite bonus points. ISS cross-band repeater contacts are also valid AMSAT Field Day satellite contacts.

The ARISS cross-band repeater uplink is 145.990 MHz (67 Hz tone), with a downlink of 437.800 MHz. ARISS suggests that those unfamiliar with the ISS repeater may want to practice with it prior to Field Day. ARISS had planned to switch modes to the Automatic Packet Reporting System (APRS) during the second week of June, but this won't happen until after the first ARISS school contact following ARRL Field Day.

The ARISS ham station will be off-air during spacewalks on June 16 and June 20.

David K5NN called the meeting to order.

Jack AA5VZ informed the membership this month's presentation would be a continuation of last month's presentation on setting up a Raspberry Pi for use in the ham shack.

Andy KB2VQA noted that the May newsletter contained the minutes from the April meetings. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Maurice KM5RF reviewed the financial report of April 2021. A motion was made and carried to accept the report for audit as published. Maurice reported that the repeater is working well.

Trey AF5XS compiled and distributed the newsletter for May 2021.

Phil N5PWW holds testing sessions promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 401 W. Sanford Street (use the entrance on the north side). The FCC now requires that those taking an exam have an FCC Registration Number (FRN) and email address on file. Phil confirmed that the meeting room is available for the club to use for membership meetings and Field Day activities.

Bill AE5BT announced that Field Day 2021 was 36 days away. He has arranged for a BBQ dinner on the Saturday of Field Day. He needs assistance with side dishes, asking the membership to bring such items as beans, potato salad, and fruit salad. For radio operations during Field Day, two rooms will be used to accommodate social distancing. Bill will invite the local fire house to dinner and observe radio operations.

At the membership meeting in June, Rob W5WS will provide a presentation on Field Day operations and answer questions from the membership.
