Meeting Minutes

January 2022 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order on January 21st, 2022, at 7:31 pm by the President, Jack AA5VZ, accompanied by a teleconference simulcast. Other board members present included Vice President, Philip KD5WDW; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Emergency Coordinator, Bill AE5BT; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Jack AA5VZ called the meeting to order, and asked attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign. He informed the membership that the Ham of the Year was declared at the December holiday party, the recipient of the award being David K5NN. Jack welcomed Philip KD5WDW to the board, serving in the position of vice president. This evening's presentation will be given by Jack, continuing on the topic of FM satellites.

Philip KD5WDW mentioned the upcoming community event known as the Mansfield Saint Patrick's Pickle Parade and Palooza. It's an opportunity to enter an AARC float into the parade, as well as provide assistance during the parade, the 5-k, 10-k, and Kid-k races. Volunteers will also be needed during the Arlington Fourth of July Parade.

A motion was made and carried to pay the \$50 fee to enter a float in the Mansfield Saint Patrick's Pickle Parade.

Andy KB2VQA noted that the January newsletter contained the minutes from the November meetings. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Maurice KM5RF reviewed the financial reports of November and December 2021. A motion was made and carried to accept the November 2021 report for audit as published. A motion was made and carried to accept the December 2021 report for audit as published. Maurice informed the membership that he successfully completed the process of setting up a PayPal account under the name of the AARC as a 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization. This change in classification results in the club paying lower transaction fees.

He would like to organize an audit of the club's financial records for 2021 at the February club meeting. Three club members volunteered to participate on the audit committee.

Maurice informed the membership that the Yaesu DR-2 repeater was installed in late 2021 and it's working well.

Trey AF5XS compiled and distributed the newsletter for January 2022. All submissions are welcomed and requested to be received by the Saturday before the club meeting. If you volunteer at an event, snap a picture, and submit it.

Phil N5PWW holds testing sessions promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 401 W. Sanford Street (use the entrance on the north side). There are no training classes being held at this time.

Bill AE5BT informed the membership that Field Day 2022 was 155 days away, starting on Saturday, June 25th. He reviewed how the club prepares for and participates in Field Day.

Jack AA5VZ shared with the membership his vision for the club's direction in 2022. It focused on four areas which included growing the membership, promoting club activities, new learning opportunities, and

encouraging deep involvement in the club and community.

Old business: No old business was presented.

New business: Trey suggested that the club invest in its own Zoom account. A motion was made and carried for an expenditure to cover the purchase of a Zoom account held by the AARC.

A break was taken at 8:24 pm. The meeting resumed at 8:33 pm with a presentation entitled Getting Started with FM Satellites part 2, given by Jack AA5VZ.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 pm. The sign-in sheet showed 22 people in attendance, 20 indicating AARC membership. Zoom attendees numbered 7.
